# 2009 WISCONSIN STATE SHOOT

Mark your calendars! This years WI State Trapshoot is to be held from July 14th through the 19th.

As by now you have probably heard, the WTA was able to reach an agreement with the Waukesha Gun Club to continue holding the shoot at the WGC for not only 2009 but for 2010 as well. With this agreement, there are many changes in store for this years shoot. Here are a few.

First as part of the agreement, your WTA Board of Directors will be running the shoot. The WTA's agreement with the WGC is a lease agreement for the grounds and the facility. This is a major change from how the shoot was run the past several years. Now, while the shoots have gotten better, make no mistake, we will continue to build on that and even take it to the next level. Our goal is to make not only the shoot successful, but more importantly, an enjoyable time for those that attend.

Another change is that we have set up committees for the shoot. Most of the setup and coordination of this years shoot is being handled by SE

Zone Director Brad Patterson. He is coordinating not only the efforts with the WGC to see that the facility is ready to go , but in addition is handling the hiring of labor to include the office staff as well as the trap line help as well. He is also coordinating with the vendors.

Camping is being coordinated by NE Zone Director, Bill Simonar. Bill has worked very hard setting up the sites, figuring out who is where and what the needs are. By the time you receive this, if you had a camping spot in the past, you will have received this years invoice agreement.

Another big change is that this years shoot is going electronic. Gone are the paper entry cards. The WTA has purchased computers and we will be using the 3S program this year. This is an exciting change, however, please be patient as we implement this new system.

Presquadding will be available again this year. It has proven to be very popular and by presquadding, you have more control over when and over which traps you shoot. Not to mention, you don't have to stand in line to squad. Presquadding be-

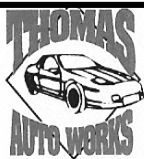

## A Word From SE Zone Director Brad Patterson

I wanted to touch on a few thoughts regarding this year's state shoot. As many of you have heard, I am coordinating much of this year's shoot and plans are well under way for you to come and enjoy a great week shooting, sharing fellowship, hopefully winning a trophy or two.

As has been reported, the WTA has entered into a lease agreement with the Waukesha Gun Club. For the week, we will be leasing the grounds and running the shoot. Now while they will not be as active in partnership as in the past, the Waukesha Gun Club is still an important part of this year's shoot. Behind the scenes, the WGC has been busy with many improvements. They are busy building benches, upgrading scorer chairs, painting, continuing the winter trap machine maintenance schedule.

The WGC liaison, Pete Williams has been extremely helpful as has the WGC Board of Directors. Make no mistake, the WGC has the same mission as we do, to provide you with the very best experience we can during state shoot week.

Let me update you on some of the behind the scenes stuff we already have done. All of the support elements for the shoot have been

contracted. (trailer, garbage disposal, toilets, tents, tables, chairs, etc.) Thank you to Dick Otto who was very helpful to me in taking care of and contracting with the various companies.

Vender invoices have been sent out and most of our loyal vendors are returning so there will be much for you to purchase.

Camping for the shoot is being handled by Bill Simonar. Bill has made several trips down to the WGC from the Brown County area, to make sure the camping area is laid out properly and the campers are in the right spot and are charged the correct amount based if the site has electrical or not.

We will again be utilizing Pre-Squad.com for early squadding for the event. If you wish to use this option, and it is the best option if you wish to have control over the banks and traps you shoot, it will be available beginning May 1st.

New this year. The shoot is going electronic. Your Board of Directors earlier this year made the decision to purchase additional computers and will be utilizing the 3S program. Gone will be the old paper entry cards. This is an exciting

change and improvement for the shoot. With this new system, there are sure to be a few glitches as you, the shooter learn to use it and our employees. Please be patient as we work together to implement this new feature.

Lastly, I will touch on the labor that will be working the shoot this year. You will see many familiar faces, as all the girls who worked in the office last year are returning. As for the trapline, we are employing several schools. Many of the schools that provided labor at past shoots are coming back. We have already begun training and that is progressing nicely. What I would ask, is to remember that these young people are out at the shoot, doing their very best, to do a good job for you. If a mistake is made, please help them, thank them when they do well, just remember, they are there for you.

For the past several years a committee went over the thousands of scores of our shooters to figure out the team. It is a very time consuming process that is also ripe for mistakes to be made.

Therefore, while the requirements

to make the team wont change, each shooter who wishes to be on the various teams will have to fill out a All-State team selection application.

The applications will be made available beginning at the state shoot and will also be available on the WTA website.

The big thing to remember is if you

do not fill out a All-State team selection application, you will not be considered for the teams.

Applications will be due by December 31st and the team will be announce after the January Board of Director's meeting.
