The WTA Hall of Fame Committee recently received a complaint against one of the Wisconsin Trapshooting Associations Hall of Fame inductees. There currently is no process for either the Board or the HOF Committee to adhere to when investigating a complaint.

The Hall of Fame Committee would like the Board of Directors to review and approve the following process:

A. The complaint must be in writing, identify the inductee in question, identify the person making the complaint and must clearly state the reason(s) for removal.

B. The Board could either appoint a special committee to handle complaint or instruct the Hall of Fame Committee to do so. It would be this committees responsibility to substantiate the complaint, gather evidence and make a recommendation to the Board of Directors.

C. The Board of Directors would vote on the recommendation made by the committee. It is the Hall of Fame Committee's opinion that removal from the Hall of Fame should only be done by a unanimous vote of the entire Board (not just those present).

D. The committee would inform, in writing, the person making the complaint of their findings and of any subsequent vote by the Board.

E. The Hall of Fame Committee further recommends that all HOF complaints that are made, all discussion of HOF complaints, all recommendations on HOF complaints and all voting by the Board on HOF complaints be done in executive session.
