Magic Number Shootoff

At the conclusion of the day's events, a magic number will be drawn. All scores ending with that number will be eligible to shootoff for prizes to be determined. A shooter may only shootoff once, regardless of how many of their scores end with the magic number. The shootoff will be miss-and-out.

Dan Murphy Doubles Skills Clinic
