RE: Zone Shoot Standardized Program Minimum Requirements

The following are the minimum requirements set forth by the WTA Board of Directors for the zone shoot programs. If you have any questions, please contact Rick Tesker, Kevin Doerring, or Dwight Paulin.

- Minimum of \$1800 in **CASH PRIZE MONEY** for the In-Zone competitors
- **200 Target 16-yard Championship:**
 - In Zone – Champion, Runner Up, Classes AA-D, Junior, Lady, Veteran
 - AA: 97 and up
 - A: 94 and under 97
 - B: 91 and under 94
 - C: 88 and under 91
 - D: under 88
- **100 Target Handicap Championship:**
 - In Zone – Champion, 1st in each yardage group, Runner Up in each yardage group, Junior, Lady, Veteran
 - 18-21
 - 22-23
 - 24-25
 - 26-27
- **100 Target Doubles Championship**
 - In Zone – Champion, Class Winner, Runner Up in each class
 - AA: 93 and up
 - A: 89 and under 93
 - B: 85 and under 89
 - C: 78 and under 85
 - D: under 78
- Options, Additional Trophies, & Added Money may be added as a club sees fit.

Programs are due to the delegate or alternate delegate by December 15th
